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<p><b>Honors Priority Registration</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Priority registration allows Honors students to register for classes before other undergraduate students and provides the opportunity to complete academic Honors course requirements.</li> <li>Keep an eye on your Panthermail (student email) for communications from the Registrars' office regarding registration dates.</li> </ul>
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<p><b>Retention Policy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher to remain academically eligible to participate in the Honors program.</li> </ul>
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
