Honors Advising

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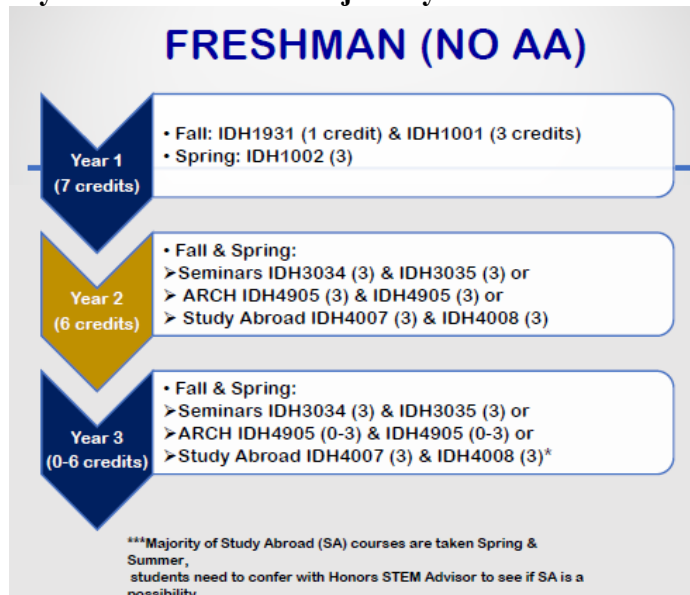
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- Social Media:

If student takes UCC courses for a major requirement, then elective credits are earned

- **7 courses total, 3 from Year 1 (some Honors/IDH courses are a year-long/2 semester sequence)**

Honors Priority Registration

- Priority registration allows Honors students to register for classes before other undergraduate students and provides the opportunity to complete academic Honors course requirements.
- Keep an eye on your Panthermail (student email) for communications from the Registrars' office regarding registration dates.

Retention Policy

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher to remain academically eligible to participate in the Honors program.
